CHUCK WAGON GUIDELINES

- **Who can volunteer?**

Groups of four to eight volunteers — families, friends, coworkers, churches, or any caring group — are welcome to join. If your group is larger, consider splitting into smaller teams or scheduling multiple meals on different days to avoid overcrowding the kitchen.

- **What do Chuck Wagon volunteers do?**

Your team will provide a complete meal, serve it to families, and clean up afterward. Meals can be homemade or catered, but warm, hearty, comforting dishes are best. You can cook on site using our fully equipped kitchen or bring food prepared elsewhere with heating instructions.

- **When and where are meals served?**

Dinner is served at 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday. Volunteers should arrive between four thirty and five p.m. to set up and prepare. Our kitchen has two cooking stations and is stocked with all necessary pots, bakeware, and utensils.

- **How many people do we cook for?**

Plan to serve about twenty to thirty people. We will email your group the exact headcount and the previous week's menu the Wednesday before your meal date to help with planning and avoid menu duplication.

- **What kind of food should we bring?**

Hearty, family-friendly meals are always a hit. Examples include casseroles, pasta, pork chops, baked potatoes with toppings, or other dishes with a protein, side, and dessert if possible.

Families arrive and eat throughout the evening — some early, some later — and often reheat leftovers for midnight snacks or the next day's lunch.

- **Do we need to stay and serve?**

Yes. We ask volunteers to stay for serving and to engage with families. This connection adds so much kindness and meaning to the meal experience for everyone.

- **Can we cancel or reschedule?**

We understand life happens. If you need to cancel, please notify us as early as possible so we can arrange an alternate meal for the families.

- **How do we sign up?**
